Cllr R Tillyer advised that any bloke paving over 5m2 needed planning permission. It was therefore decided that a record of all properties exceeding the permitted size built within the past 11 years would be presented at the next meeting. The Clerk will then advise the enforcement officer. Cllr Mrs F Bovingdon suggested this this issue be included in the Neighbourhood Plan.

Cllr R Tillyer reported that he had received complaints from the residents of Mill Lane concerning the use of 'Iona' Mill Lane for business purposes; a white van delivery service, resulting in late night disturbance. The Clerk is to advise the Borough Council Planning Department.

Cllr N Cole reported that The Crown Public House is displaying advertisements on the Village Green. It was considered that this was unsightly and obscured drivers' vision. The Clerk is write to the Landlord requesting that they be removed.

Cllr Mrs E Coogan reported that due to inconsiderate parking around the Green the bus has en unable to pass. Neil Waters was in the process of examining the parking issues in the Village with possible resolutions. The Clerk is to contact him to determine progress so far.

**16/066 Reports from Borough Councillor C Rayer**

- Apologies were received from Cllr J Lenton.
- He was waiting to receive a date for the implementation of the extension of the 30mph speed restriction along Coppermill Road.
- There were reports of fly tipping along Stanwell Road into Horton.
- Road repairs due to take place have not yet started.
- The number of vehicles travelling down Foundry Lane has increased considerably.
- Parking along Coppermill Rd remains a problem.
- Complaints have been received concerning overhanging trees, Streetcare have been

- National Grid has been asked to remove cuttings put in the River Colne following tree cutting work under pylons.
- Cemex has awarded the right to use Kingsmead Quarry for land fill to Cappagh for the next 25 years, planning permission has been given. Mr Andrew Scott is to be asked to make a presentation to the Parish Council on the situation.
- The Brendon O'Reilly proposed development has been included in the Neighbourhood Plan.

**Reports from the Neighbourhood Plan**

- The Clerk advised that the consultation period for the Draft Plan is to start on 3<sup>rd</sup> September with a presentation at the Wraysbury Village Garden Party. Further meetings have been arranged at Champney Hall on 20<sup>th</sup> September and Wraysbury Village Hall on 10<sup>th</sup> October for residents to make any comments.
