The accounts for payment were notified to Members of the Parish Council proposed, seconded and accepted for payment and cheques signed accordingly.

Cllr C Rayner suggested that the relationship between the Champney Hall and the Parish Council in regard to financial commitments should be placed on the agenda for next month.

16/053 Reports from:

- Borough Councillor. - Councillor Lenton was not present. Cllr C Rayner advised that funding had been found to implement the extension of the 30mph speed restriction along Coppermill Road. The Cllrs were fully in favour of the proposal. Cllr C Rayner had received a request for Capital Project ideas for 2017/18 and made the following suggestions;
 1. Replacement of street lighting suitable for a village.
 2. Improvements to the Village Green, the car park, and pavements.

Parking along Coppermill Road was still an issue with people going to the Wraysbury Station parking there. The yellow lines could be extended or parking could be restricted to residents only.

- Horton and Wraysbury Neighbourhood Planning Group – The next meeting is on Thursday 28th July. The Clerk advised that the draft Plan is to be discussed at Wraysbury Parish Council meeting on Monday 15th August and Cllr Mrs M Lenton had invited Horton Parish Council to attend. Cllr Mrs E Coogan is to contact Jane to request her involvement in the process.

16/054 Youth Activities

Fun in the Sun is due to take place on 1st and 16th August and Cllr E Coogan offered to help.

16/055 Wraysbury Station Foot Bridge

All the finances have been agreed and work is to start in October.

16/056 Defibrillator

Cllr C Rayner advised that he had a £750 allowance for local community projects and would like to use it to purchase a defibrillator for the village. He suggested that a possible site would be the Village Shop. The total cost including a secure container would be in the region of £2000 but other funding may be available.

16/057 Questions from the Public -

Mr B O’Rielly presented his proposed development of 2, 3, 4 and 5 bedroom properties along Coppermill Road. The plot is approximately 380m long by 40 to 50m deep. He asked the Proportion of starter homes/ social housing that would be required in order for the proposal to be included in the Neighbourhood Plan. Cllr Mrs F Bovingdon suggested that he contact the Neighbourhood Plan Committee Chaired by Cllr Mr M Lenton. Cllr Mr C Rayner advised that the Parish could not make comment on the proposal until full planning application had been submitted.
